

Tribute to the Troops Scholarship Application

The following guidelines for \$500 School Support Fund for Tribute to the Troops:

1. Applicant must be a Massachusetts Resident and prove identification with a military id or Form dd2-14.
2. Applicant must be from a branch of the US Military Service including: Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, National Guard, Coast Guard.
3. Applicant may be from anyone of the following: Veteran, Active Duty, Active Reserve, or National Guard.
4. Applicant must prove school enrollment for themselves, spouse, or a dependent. Enrollment is defined as a student in a class of education.
5. Applicant may use funds toward Education goals for themselves, a spouse, or a child dependent, including tuition, room, board if enrolled college or university.
6. Check may be used for school supplies including laptop, desktop, calculators, books, notebooks, writing supplies, paper, fees.
7. Check will be delivered to School of choice in name of applicant or applicant's family member or delivered to applicant based on itemized receipt of eligible items in point #5.
8. Applicant must show receipt to show school supplies purchased and request reimbursement.
9. Applicant must perform a 10 hour community service project at the direction of the James Rice Post Amvets Post 28 Commander in Dorchester, before any funds are distributed. This may involve any number of activities including tasks such as: organizing Tribute Scholarship event, local parade participant, homeless shelter volunteer, honor guard duty, or event to be determined.
10. Applicants may apply for 1 scholarship annually. Only one scholarship per family per student.
11. Applicant must sign application in writing and fill out required questions/fields. Applications available from email jkm97fundir@hotmail.com.
12. Deadline for Applications will be March 1st annually. Committee will ensure all guidelines completed by applicant. At least four members of committee must approve any scholarships.
13. All scholarships granted at the discretion of committee.
14. All monetary funds limited to the amounts held for benefit of this special project fund.
